## Remote SSH Connections with Command Line in Linux

Enter the following information in the command line:

# ssh username@owl.iasbs.ac.ir

Password: Your password

### Remote SSH Connections with WinSCP in Windows

### 1. Install WinSCP

If you haven't already done so, download WinSCP5 and install it.



### 2. Set Up WinSCP

Open WinSCP

On the log in screen that appears, enter the following information:

File protocol: **SFTP** Host name: **owl.iasbs.ac.ir** Port number: **22** User name: Your username (Do not include "@iasbs.ac.ir" after your ID) Password: Your password

#### 3. Upload Your Files

A window showing your local computer on the left and your home directory on the right opens. You are now ready to transfer files. Drag the files to an appropriate folder in the Remote Site on the right, e.g. /home/youraccount.



#### 4. Deleting a File From Your Home Directory Renaming a File in Your Home Directory

On the home directory (remote) side of your window, click a file to select it. From the **Files** menu, select **Delete**.

In the **Confirm** dialog box, click **OK**. The file is deleted.

#### 5. Renaming a File in Your Home Directory



On the home directory (remote) side of your window, click a file to select it. From the **Files** menu, select **Rename**.

The file name becomes editable. Make whatever changes to the file name you wish.

Click anywhere outside the file name to save the changes.

#### 6. Closing Your Connection

In the top right corner of the **WinSCP** file transfer window, click the **red X**. In the **Confirm** dialog box, click **OK**. This closes your connection to the host computer, and closes the window.
