


Please check your computer's IP address before installing the printer. It should look like as follows (based on your section):



















In this section, enter the IP address of the desired printer based on the table 1











the menu on the right, download the driver with the driver and install it. (It is worth mentioning that most printers' drivers are available in drive Y)











Follow the steps below to enable automatic double side printing.
